Although the M.Sc. Program WASTE is taught in English, and the pre-requisite for admission is basic knowledge in German Language (Basic User A1 under the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - CEFR*). Furthermore, the mandatory German language classes during the first and second semesters are a part of the M.Sc. WASTE curriculum, which will lead to **Basic User A2 under the CEFR**.

<u>Students who are not German native speakers or cannot show a German proficiency certificate</u> (German language knowledge **Basic User A2** under the *CEFR*) have to participate in **the German Language Intensive Course starting on Monday, September 1st, 2025**. The intensive course prepares for extensive German Language Courses that will take place in the first and second semesters.

Students with good German knowledge of Basic User A2 might be exempted from the mandatory intensive course and the mandatory two-semester courses by filling in this form of exemption. The students being exempted from the German Course have to participate and pass two courses each with 3 ECTS from the key qualifications catalogue.

If you can show a German proficiency certificate (Basic User A2 under the CEFR) you can apply for exemption from the German Courses.
